Our charity mission is to help homeless dogs in need – no matter how far we have to travel, how long it takes to make them whole or how much money is required – we are a dedicated group of volunteers who believe all dogs deserve to be in loving homes. We only help dogs who are in danger of being euthanized and need our support as their last hope.

We have partnered with small rescue efforts in "high kill" areas around the country by sending supplies, paying for spay and neuter surgeries and taking dogs into our new program called, "The Red Dog Project". This program pairs dogs from shelters with qualified inmate handlers to give the dogs time to rehabilitate and then go on to find their forever homes. This program is based on the idea that saving one dog really means we're saving two as the inmate working with the dogs learns about teamwork, socially acceptable behaviors and how to predict and plan for healthy living environments.

Twice per year we have adoption events to help small rescue find homes for their dogs and so far we've placed over 1500 dogs at these events since we started in 2010. Our monthly, smaller events showcase the dogs in the Red Dog Project and those are held at retail and business locations around the state of Connecticut.
