Introducing a new dog to the “resident dog” can be difficult challenging so we require adopters bring their dogs from home so we can see if their potential new dog is a good match. Very experienced dog handlers or licensed trainers ONLY should manage actual dog meeting (we call that a “Meet and Greet”) and other station volunteers are managing the incoming adopters from Station 4, asking if there is a dog waiting in their car.

- Confirm Previous Stations have been initialed with orange marker.
- Ask a General Volunteer to keep a list of who is waiting for a Meet and Greet.
- Review Best Practices for (Ten Minutes Only): (1) First Week At Home – Quiet Time is Mandatory (2) Use Only Martingale Collars (3) Flight Risk (4) Use of a Crate (5) Importance of Training
- Sign Adopter Checklist with any notes to Rescue.
- Adopter Takes All Paperwork to 6**
