



Rescue

The rescue station has all rescue representative seated to meet with incoming adopters interested in their dogs. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU STAY AT THIS STATION IF YOU HAVE DOGS UP FOR ADOPTION AT THE EVENT! Rescue representatives review the paperwork and recommendations by previous station leaders and decide whether to issue a contract for adoption. ALL ADOPTIONS ARE APPROVED BY RESCUE REPRESENTATIVES ONLY – Dog Days volunteers only support rescues we don't have the final say on who is adopted or who isn't.

- Have 6 Scouts in station to (1) flip kennel cards when dogs are adopted and (2) update Adopt a Pet and Petfinder when dogs are adopted.
- Confirm Previous Stations have been initialed with orange marker.
- Review interview & application info and before you speak to the adopter please remember a few points:
 - An adopter living more than 45 minutes from the event site needs approval to adopt for the purposes of doing a home visit.
 - Please do NOT tell adopters that your dog is 'good with children' or 'housebroken' or 'good with cats' even if you know that to be true. Dogs will be returned to you, at great expense to you, if the adopter says, "the rescue said..."
- If Approved, Issue your Adoption Contract, we will make copies for you. **NOTE: Please add dog's ID (check the dog binder) to the contract!** Payment will be made at Station 10.
- Send a runner to Kennel Station 3 to turn over dog's kennel card AND let the Ranger know the dog is adopted.
- Update dogs record (ask a Scout) in Adopt a Pet and Petfinder as "Adopted".
- Sign Adopter Checklist and ask a runner to take all paperwork to Station 8 (Records)
